

Data protection policy

Anonymous data collection

You can visit our website without disclosing any personal information. In this connection we do not save personal data. In order to improve our website we evaluate statistical data only, which cannot be traced back to you.

Use of cookies

The website uses cookies. Cookies are small text files that are stored on your computer and saved by your browser. They serve to make our website more user-friendly, more effective and safer. Cookies do not contain personal data.

Profile

To register on our website you must provide your email address and a user name. Only the username you select is visible to other users. You can display other data in your profile such as your full name, your location and social media profiles, and make your email address visible to other users. The personal data you provide is stored, processed and used to the extent provided by you. The use of this data is limited to the presentation of your profile in the forum.
